Step 1

Download or open Libby on your device:

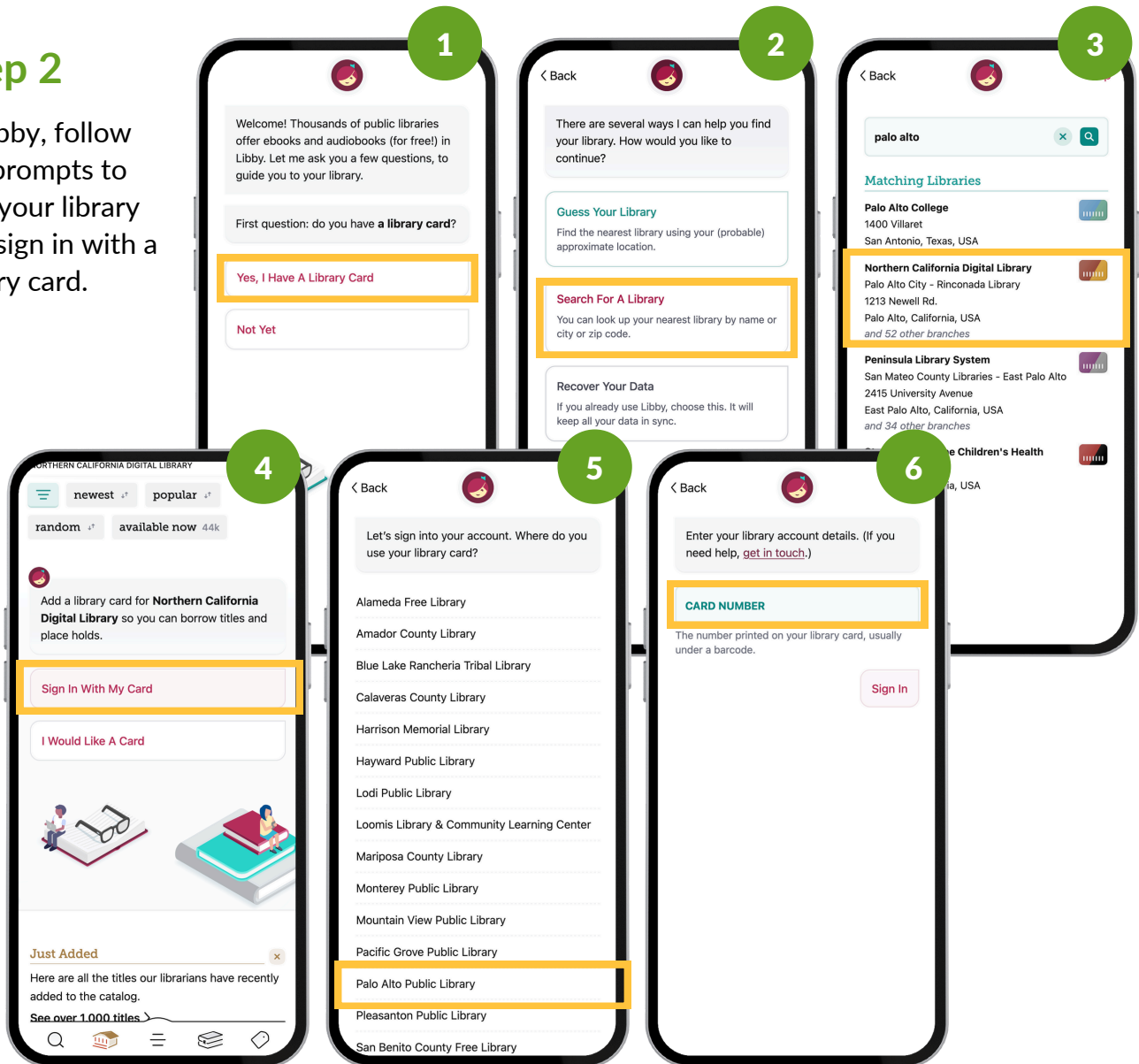

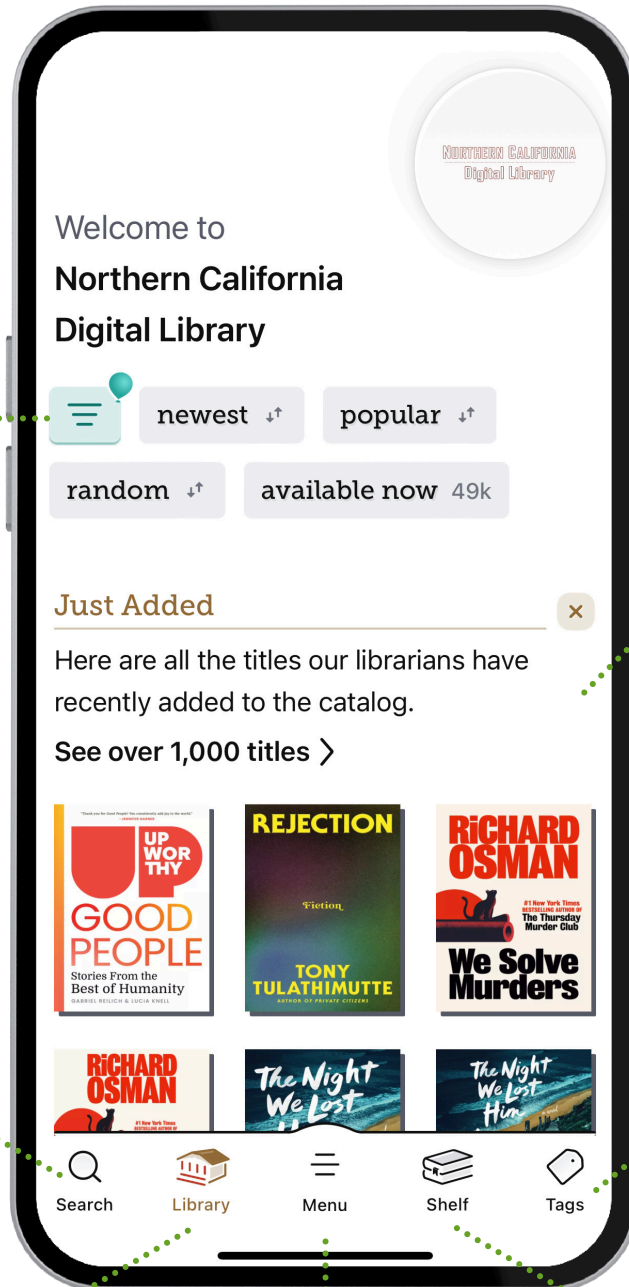

In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a library card.

Tags

View your tags here. Tags allow you to organize titles in Libby. You can create as many tags as you'd like. Ex: You can create a tag for "Books I Want to Read" or "Favorites"

Library

Opens the library collection you were most recently browsing

Menu

Change settings, add another library card, get help, and more

Shelf

See your loans, holds, and magazines for all your libraries, access your timeline, and check your notices



How to use the audio player:

1. **Back:** Takes you back to your loans
2. **Speed:** Adjust playback speed
3. **Moon:** Set a sleep timer
4. **Multiple Bookmarks:** View bookmarks and highlights
5. **Bookmark:** Tap to place a bookmark. Tap again to add a note.
 - To highlight a section, press down on the icon until it changes color. Continue holding down until you've reached the end of the section you want to highlight.
6. **Progress:** Displays progress
7. **Book Cover:** Tap for description of book and time spent reading
8. **Play or pause and 15 sec. rewind/fast forward buttons**
9. **Rewind:** Rewinds to the beginning of current chapter
10. **Chapter Menu:** Jump to another chapter
11. **Fast Forward:** Fast forward to the end of the current chapter
12. **Timeline:** Swipe to move forward or backward in the audiobook
13. **Pointer Finger:** Jumps to last position
14. **Thumbprint:** See a list of your recent places
